#1 PRESCRIBED BIOLOGIC FOR ASTHMA¹

INDICATION: DUPIXENT is a prescription medicine used with other asthma medicines for the maintenance treatment of moderate-to-severe eosinophilic or oral steroid dependent asthma in adults and children 6 years of age and older whose asthma is not controlled with their current asthma medicines. DUPIXENT helps prevent severe asthma attacks (exacerbations) and can improve your breathing. DUPIXENT may also help reduce the amount of oral corticosteroids you need while preventing severe asthma attacks and improving your breathing. DUPIXENT is not used to relieve sudden breathing problems and will not replace an inhaled rescue medicine. It is not known if DUPIXENT is safe and effective in children with asthma under 6 years of age.

WHAT CAN CAUSE ASTHMA SYMPTOMS?

Some of the most common asthma triggers are:

- exercise
- respiratory infections
- pet dander or dust
- irritants like cleaning products or perfume
- weather conditions

What's more, **underlying inflammation can still be there even when you don't have symptoms.**

With treatment, this inflammation in the lungs may be reduced, allowing you to breathe better.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Do not use if you are allergic to dupilumab or to any of the ingredients in DUPIXENT®.

Before using DUPIXENT, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you: have a parasitic (helminth) infection; are scheduled to receive any vaccinations. You should not receive a "live vaccine" right before and during treatment with DUPIXENT; are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known whether DUPIXENT will harm your unborn baby. A pregnancy registry for women who take DUPIXENT during pregnancy collects information about the health of you and your baby. It is not known whether DUPIXENT passes into your breast milk.

HOW IT WORKS

BEFORE DUPIXENT



The chronic underlying inflammation in asthma may cause airways to become constricted and narrow, making it harder to breathe.

AFTER DUPIXENT



DUPIXENT helps reduce underlying inflammation.

HOW IS DUPIXENT DIFFERENT?



It's a prescription biologic that targets an underlying cause of asthma in the lungs



It's not a steroid or inhaler

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: **Especially tell your healthcare provider if you** are taking oral, topical, or inhaled corticosteroid medicines or use an asthma medicine. **Do not** change or stop your other medicines, including corticosteroid medicine or other asthma medicine without talking to your healthcare provider. 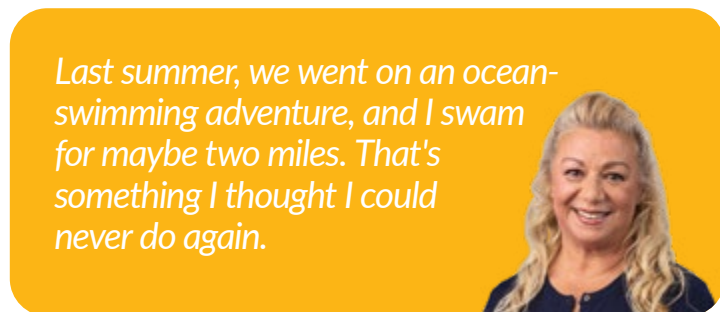

DU MORE YOU

DUXENT targets a key source of chronic airway inflammation that makes asthma difficult to control.

In multiple clinical studies, people taking DUXENT saw improvements, including:

- LESS SHORTNESS OF BREATH
- LESS WHEEZING
- NOT WAKING AT NIGHT
- INCREASED ABILITY TO DO NORMAL ACTIVITIES

The relationship between DUXENT and these results was studied but not definitively proven.

The most common side effects include injection site reactions, pain in the throat (oropharyngeal pain), and high count of a certain white blood cell (eosinophilia), with the addition of parasitic (helminth) infections observed in children.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: DUXENT can cause serious side effects, including: Allergic reactions. DUXENT can cause allergic reactions that can sometimes be severe. Stop using DUXENT and tell your healthcare provider or get emergency help right away if you get any of the following signs or symptoms: breathing problems or wheezing, swelling of the face, lips, mouth, tongue, or throat, fainting, dizziness, feeling lightheaded, fast pulse, fever, hives, joint pain, general ill feeling, itching, skin rash, swollen lymph nodes, nausea or vomiting, or cramps in your stomach-area.

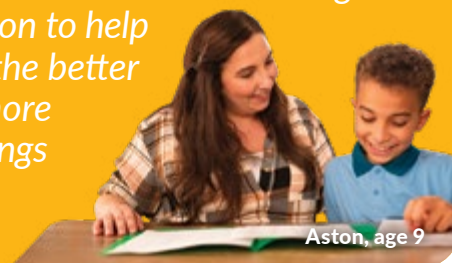

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Inflammation of your blood vessels. Rarely, this can happen in people with asthma who receive DUPIXENT. This may happen in people who also take a steroid medicine by mouth that is being stopped or the dose is being lowered. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you have: rash, chest pain, worsening shortness of breath, brown or dark colored urine, persistent fever, or a feeling of pins and needles or numbness of your arms or legs.

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RELYING ON ORAL STEROIDS?

While they may be helpful when prescribed, **long-term use of oral steroids** can cause:

- WEIGHT GAIN
- MOOD CHANGE
- HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE
- DIABETES
- VISION PROBLEMS

This may not be an exhaustive list of side effects associated with oral steroid use.

USING THE RULE OF 2
CAN HELP YOU DETERMINE HOW WELL YOUR ASTHMA IS CONTROLLED



- YOU USE A RESCUE INHALER MORE THAN **2X** A WEEK
- YOU HAD **2 OR MORE** COURSES OF ORAL STEROIDS IN THE LAST YEAR
- YOU HAD **2 OR MORE** ASTHMA ATTACKS IN THE LAST YEAR
- YOU WAKE UP AT NIGHT **2 OR MORE** TIMES A MONTH DUE TO ASTHMA

Talk to your doctor about your asthma and ask if DUPIXENT could be right for you.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Psoriasis. This can happen in people with asthma who receive DUPIXENT. Tell your healthcare provider about any new skin symptoms. Your healthcare provider may send you to a dermatologist for an examination if needed.

Joint aches and pain. Some people who use DUPIXENT have had trouble walking or moving due to their joint symptoms, and in some cases needed to be hospitalized. Tell your healthcare provider about any new or worsening joint symptoms. Your healthcare provider may stop DUPIXENT if you develop joint symptoms.

The most common side effects in patients with asthma include injection site reactions, high count of a certain white blood cell (eosinophilia), pain in the throat (oropharyngeal pain), and parasitic (helminth) infections.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION: Use DUpixent exactly as prescribed by your healthcare provider. It's an injection given under the skin (subcutaneous injection). Your healthcare provider will decide if you or your caregiver can inject DUpixent. **Do not** try to prepare and inject DUpixent until you or your caregiver have been trained by your healthcare provider. In children 12 years of age and older, it's recommended DUpixent be administered by or under supervision of an adult. In children 6 to less than 12 years of age, DUpixent should be given by a caregiver.

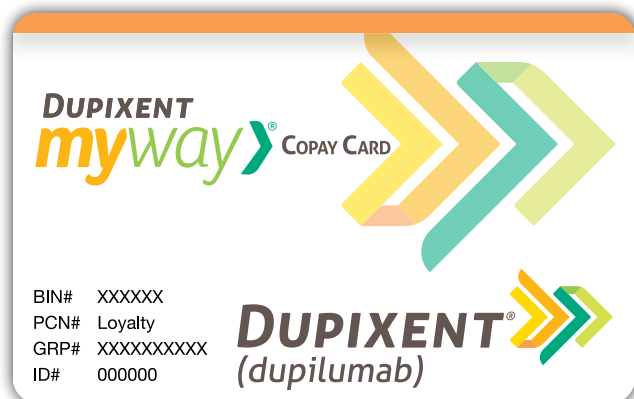

ACCESSING YOUR COPAY CARD

You can access your Copay Card in 2 ways:



Call **1-855-726-4702** to ensure Copay benefits are applied to your script



Visit **DUPIXENT.com** to apply for a card online

Once approved, provide the Copay Card numbers on your card to the specialty pharmacy when they call you to set up delivery of **DUPIXENT**. The pharmacy will apply the card to reduce your out-of-pocket costs and will note the card number in your record for future refills.

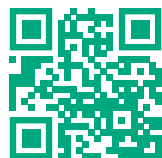
